- Cleaned up show-children.

- Fixed Selftest External loopback test. Skip echo-diag-test if F-port topology.
- Fixed Selftest Memory test return status in do-mem-test and test-mem.
- Fixed SNS commands, including x112 bug found in IBM Fcode.
- Fixed starting-id bug in show-children, obp-target got cleared if NL-port.
- Fixed bug in logout-devices. Wasn't always logging out from starting device.
- $\bullet$  Fixed stack bug in inquiry & report-luns. Add error? test to handle failed case.
- Fixed another infinite-loop bug, lip-login doesn't fix the link on comp-stat 29.
- Fixed stack bug in lip-login. Must return completion-status to execute-command.
- $\bullet$  Fixed processing of get-id-for-fc4type GID\_FT buffer to check for null buffer.
- Fixed stack bug in show-children when topology is not valid.
- Fixed infinite-loop login-device bug, when topology=loop. When return status=28 or 29 (unavail Or port-logo) execute login-loop-port if topo=loop.
